to a new friend - Lola the Bookworm. Spurred on by the chance to win Lola, no fewer than 97 young readers completed the challenge, reading six different books and making at least three library visits in the holidays.

All 97 received a certificate and a golden medallion to mark their achievement, and Lola now lives with Nook Lane's Summer Marshall.

But we have a constant need to expand and replenish the team.


